



A new 11 km sub-sea tunnel between the island Streymoy (Tórshavn) and Eysturoy (Runavík) will open late 2020 – early 2021. The tunnel will connect Skálafjørðin (Runavík/Strendur) via a roundabout under the seabed. The tunnel will shorten the travel distance between Tórshavn to Runavík/Strendur from 55 km to 17 km. Tunnel fee.
